





- I think I would change the amount of asynchronous work. I felt really overwhelmed and would spend all day working on it. I understand that there was a lot of material, but I was doing more work than I do for my 3 credit courses. Although the material was engaging, it was a lot to do at once. Also, we knew some of the technologies before taking this course, so going through them step by step is not a good use of time. If everyone in the class has used Kahoot before, then there is no need to spend time going over it. That time could be used to expose us to new resources.
- One think I would change about this course is between week 4 and 5, having more practice on writing and making a lesson plan. Another thing is to have more examples of lesson teaching in week 5 (what it should look like). The last thing I would change (if online and in-person again) is to have the week 4 in person. This way students can ask questions about there lesson plan in-person.
- Less workload or at least provide us with asynchronous work and assignments ahead of time (preferably a week ahead to support time management). Include more ways to teach assistive technology in the classroom.
- 1. Less work per week. There was way too much work for a one credit class. 2. Give students more time to work on assignments in class instead of spending hours going over the syllabus.
- · Have practice with more assistive technology.
- The workload was a lot for a one credit class. I found myself spending countless hours on homework for this class when it is a 1 credit class and I do have 5 other courses that I am taking right now. I feel that the assignments were all super helpful, but super time consuming. I think the scheduling for what/when work is due needs to be adjusted as the workload was truly a lot for this class.
- I would change the amount of technological websites we cover, it feels like too much and I would rather cover a few really in-depth. Also the work load seemed like too much for a 1 credit course.

- · I believe this course gave a very large amount of asynchronous work for being only a one credit class.
- Two things I would change about this course would be the work load that we got, and possibly getting the opportunity to meet in-person more.
- the amount of asynronous work each week and more inn person classes
- I think that Lei is a great teacher and puts a tremendous amount of work into this course. She is also very knowledgeable on the subject. However, I wish that this course focused on technologies I would use in my classroom every day. This includes learning how things like how to use applications for a smart board, google classroom, etc. Along with this I think that at least one third of the course should be dedicated to assistive technology. These are things that are crucial for educators to know, but we have not gotten an opportunity to learn extensively about them. I want to learn about sound systems for students that have hearing difficulties, apps for non verbal students, and more. The other thing I would change is the amount of work. I found myself doing an excessive amount of work for this class, this was by far my most stressful class, but only a 1 credit course. I think that the work load should be smaller to better suit a one credit course.
- I would include more in-person hands-on activities. I would also change the layout of the class to include more classwork than homework.
- Way too much work given..I fell behind in all of my other classes because of how much homework was given in this 1 credit class!! I would also make every single class synchronous and not asynchronous because people require lots of support when learning new technologies. This is very difficult to do on your own.
